

# Weekend Masses Resume

## Q: When are weekend Masses being held?

A: Weekend Masses at SS. Isidore and Maria Parish will be held as follows:

- Saturday Vigil: 4:00 p.m.
- Sunday: 8:00 a.m.
- Sunday: 9:30 a.m.
- Sunday: 11:15 a.m.

## Q: Where are our parish weekend Masses being held?

A: All weekend Masses will be held at St. Paul Church.

## Q: What is being done to determine who may attend weekend Masses?

A: There will be **online and call-in options** by which you may sign-up to attend weekend mass. Details coming soon.

## Q: May I still view the Mass via live stream from my home?

A: Yes. Starting July 4th, all weekend Masses from St. Paul Church will be live-streamed on the parish website ([www.isidoreandmaria.org](http://www.isidoreandmaria.org)), Facebook LIVE or YouTube live.

## Q: What protocols are being put in place to ensure health and safety?

A: To ensure the health and safety of all, we have implemented the following public health guidance:

- Congregation size will be limited to **approximately 100 people**
- **Face masks** are required of all members of the congregation. You may not enter the church without a face mask.
- To help maintain the recommended six-foot distance between congregants, please follow the **directional arrows and walking patterns** within the church

*We also request that anyone who is sick, at high risk or showing symptoms of illness, to please refrain from attending Mass at this time.*

## Q: What happens when I arrive at St. Paul Church for weekend Mass?

A: Upon your arrival, please enter using the front door (Main Street entrance) only, then:

- Please check in with the representative at the door, who will confirm your reservation.
- An usher will seat you at the next available open seat within the church.

**To ensure appropriate social distancing, It is imperative that you follow the instructions of the usher, and sit only where instructed.**

## Q: Will Holy Communion be made available?

A: Yes, Holy Communion will be distributed following the conclusion of Mass. It is preferred that all communicants receive the Body of Christ in the hand\*.

- Step to the side
- Lower your mask
- Consume the host
- Replace your mask
- Exit the church via the side doors following the directional arrows and walking patterns within the church.

*\*Communicants choosing to receive the Host on the tongue must wait to receive Holy Communion until all others have received and must do so using **only the Main aisle of the church**.*

## Q: I participated in Mass by watching the live stream. May I receive Holy Communion?

A: Yes! Communicants who have celebrated the Mass via broadcast means (including, but not limited to the SS. Isidore and Maria live stream, live stream of another parish, or the Office of Radio & Television for the Archdiocese of Hartford) may receive the Holy Eucharist at St. Paul Church immediately following the 11:15 a.m. celebration of Mass (approximately 12:15 p.m.).

Please enter by the Main Street entrances of the church and South Wing and carefully follow the traffic flow instructions from the ushers and the walking patterns within the church. Please wear a face mask.

## Q: What if I have additional questions about the reopening?

A: We continually be updating our messaging, which will be distributed using a variety of communication venues and tools, including:

## Inspiration for the Week

“Are you unaware that we who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death?” What do you understand these words to mean? Many see these words as an indication of what may come in eternal life. In actuality, they have more to do with our lives here and now. We are called to die to ourselves and offer our lives as gifts given generously to others. It is not about us. We are asked to serve God and not continue in our service of sin. Life is about learning to do what we really do not want to do because it brings us deeper into the mystery of God, ourselves, and others. Learning how to accept and live with the “small deaths” and sacrifices we encounter teaches us how to live with and approach our final death. We can do so with a heart that has been touched by and is open to mercy or one that is self- focused and closed.

**Harry & Oliver's Corner**



When we were baptized, we were baptized into Christ's death. Take a moment to ponder these profound words. We were baptized into death. In every sense of the word, we are asked to die. This is not just about our final death but about daily deaths due to inconvenience, discomfort, pain, loss, or others' needs. This is an incredible epiphany given the way we very often approach our lives. We do everything to avoid death, let alone encounter it! Many avoid pain, discomfort, inconvenience, uneasiness, change, interference, and suffering of any kind. We put a lot of energy into finding the easiest and least inconvenient way through many things. Even holding the door open for a stranger or saying hello to someone in the store can be major undertakings.

We are called to die. One of the biggest wake-up calls we can have is realizing that life is not about us! There are millions of other people sharing life on this planet with whom I have a relationship. Does my life celebrate those relationships? The most distracting question we can ask is, "What do I want to do?" The more focused, faith-filled question is, "What do I need to do?" What I need to do may not be what I want to do. However, asking this question more frequently will teach us how to more purposefully and intentionally live so we can be a life giving vessel for others. When we learn to live more sacrificially, to put the needs of others before our own, and to not always seek our own self-interest, we become aware of what baptism into Christ's death is really all about. These are the roots of virtue and the seedbed for justice, tolerance, solidarity, love, and peace.

Learning how to accept all the "small deaths" and sacrifices life calls us to teaches us how to approach our final death. All deaths ask us to empty ourselves into something or someone else. Whether we empty ourselves into the heart and soul of another human being or empty ourselves into God at the moment of our final death, new life is always received and nurtured. A heart that exclusively seeks its own interest is a heart that is closed to love. A heart that pours itself out to others and is content with being emptied is a heart that has been touched by and open to mercy. It is a heart that overflows with joy.


