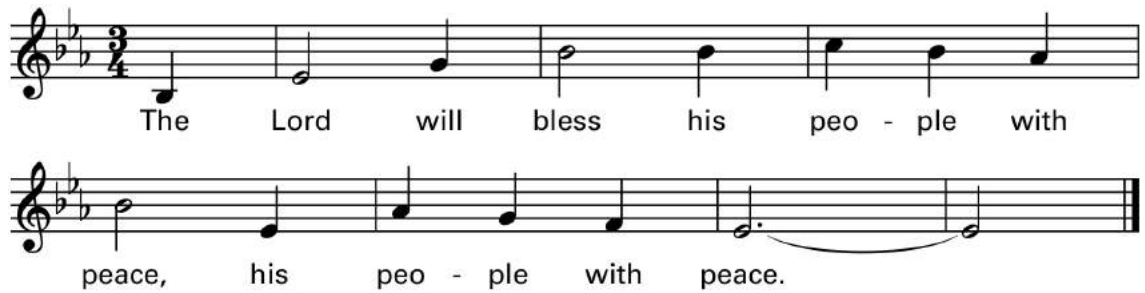

All: Amen.


