Being smart, savvy, and creative with financial wealth can be good. Being smart, savvy, and creative with living out our relationship with God is even better. Our hearts have to find a home somewhere. Jesus reminds us of a choice we must make: God or mammon. We need to be cautious about "selling our souls" to what cannot fully satisfy us and falling into the traps of lust, gluttony, pride, and greed. Instead, we can better direct our efforts and talents to manage God's kingdom, which in the end is the only thing that matters. Any ideas on how we can use the talents and skills God gave us to make for a better world?


#### "You cannot serve both God and mammon."

Merriam-Webster defines mammon as material wealth or possessions, especially having a debasing influence. While God does not take issue with our need to use money for the business of our lives, there can be a problem with the attitudes we bring to it. We can easily become so preoccupied and obsessed with money that it becomes the real "god" we worship. Do we serve mammon instead of God? In their book, "Wealth, Riches and Money," Craig Hill and Earl Pitts outline symptoms of mammon's influence in our lives. These are worry and anxiety over money, money mismanagement, fear over "never having enough," an "I can't afford it" mentality, impulse buying, stinginess, greed, debt, and discontent.

Many things on that list can consume us to the point that we are distracted from what we need to do. Many people spend excessive time worrying about money, which becomes the source of their worst fears. If we are honest with ourselves, we must admit that we place far more emphasis on our material securities than we ought. We have convinced ourselves that we cannot live without it. Are we that certain about the presence of God? Many of the world's problems, especially inequity and in- justice, result from conflicts about money. Many equate money with happiness. Those successful in accumulating large amounts of money quickly realize just how wrong they are.

"Your ultimate allegiance is not to the government, not to the state, not to nation, not to any man-made institution. The Christian owes his ultimate allegiance to God, and if any earthly institution conflicts with God's will, it is your Christian duty to take a stand against it. You must never allow the transitory evanescent demands of man-made institutions to take precedence over the eternal demands of the Almighty God (Martin Luther King, Jr.)." This is the point Jesus is trying to make. Unfortunately, when we look around, our man-made kingdoms are far more prevalent than God's kingdom. When we start seeing greater evidence of justice, equity, dignity, respect, opportunity, gentleness, holiness, solidarity, honesty, simplicity, care for creation, and a decrease in ambition, we will then know that God's kingdom is being served. We will be doing what we are supposed to do.



## This Day in History — Sept. 22

September 22 is the 265th day of the year in the Gregorian calendar; 100 days remain until the end of the year. It is frequently the day of the **autumnal equinox** in the Northern Hemisphere.

An **equinox** is the instant in time when the plane of earth's equator passes through the geometric center of the Sun's disk. This occurs twice each year, around 20 March and 23 September. It is the moment at which the center of the visible sun is directly above the equator.

**Autumn**, also known as Fall is one of the four temperate seasons. Outside the tropics, autumn marks the transition from summer to winter, in September when the duration of daylight becomes noticeably shorter with cooler temperatures. Day length decreases as the season progresses until the Winter Solstice in December.


