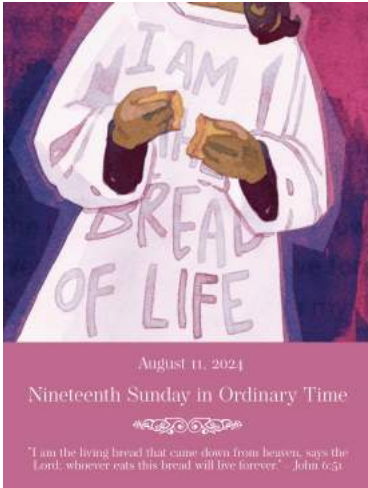

**Blessed Michael McGivney, pray for us.**

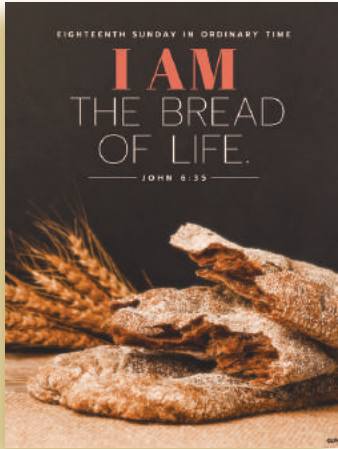
