

Mary, Mother of the church, pray for us. Saint Joseph, Patron of our Archdiocese, pray for us. Blessed Michael McGivney, pray for us.






### **Communion Hymns**


3. Jesus, meek and humble, mercy born of pain, on the cross we fashioned from our sin and shame, God himself providing Lamb and sacrifice.
