

2026 COMMUNITY GARDEN PLOT GUIDELINES

1. Community garden plots are located behind the Police Department at 2108 Main Street. They can be entered from Canione Road. Plots measure either 20' x 40' or 20' x 20'. They will be plowed, staked and ready for use on **SATURDAY, MAY 2**.
2. Please park in either the area set aside for parking adjacent to the Little League field or on the gravel drive adjacent to gardens. Space is limited. Please be considerate of others.
3. Walkways between plots must be kept free of obstruction to permit access to all plots. This is the responsibility of the gardener(s) adjoining a walkway(s).
4. The use of herbicides is prohibited. This includes weed killers, many of which remain in the soil for several years and can cause damage to crops in succeeding years.
5. Please be considerate when watering. A sufficient number of spigots have been provided for the gardens as long as they are not monopolized by individual use. For that reason, the use of drip irrigation is discouraged. Please be fair and reasonable in the use of water. **Do not leave water running unattended.** The utility costs for water each year are significant.
6. All debris (wooden stakes, black plastic, fencing, ropes, etc.) **MUST** be removed by **MONDAY, OCTOBER 12**. The Town of Glastonbury **IS NOT RESPONSIBLE** for items left after this time.
7. For those gardening in 20' x 20' gardens with an adjacent gardener (23 A&B thru 27 A&B), please plant your first row back 18" from the adjacent garden as walkways between the two gardens could not be afforded and still have the plots meet the plan. Following the 18" guideline will ensure a 3' walkway between the gardens.
8. **FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH GUIDELINES MAY RESULT IN LOSS OF YOUR GARDEN PLOT FOR FUTURE YEARS.**
